WHY NONECHKA-USA?

MEANS "CLOSE TO YOU" IN NAHUATL, ONE OF THE PREVALENT INDIGENOUS LANGUAGES SPOKEN BY MEXICO'S MIGRANT AGRICULTURAL LABORERS WHERE THE PROJECT WAS IMPLEMENTED.

THE PROJECT IS SO NAMED BECAUSE IT WAS DESIGNED TO CONNECT DIRECTLY WITH THESE OFTEN ISOLATED WORKERS



CAMPESINOS SIN FRONTERAS (CSF)



- Yuma County is in the border with San Luis, R.C. Sonora/Mexico (have a high transit of migrant farmworkers)
- Yuma County provides 90% of all leafy vegetables in the United States (lettuce, broccoli, celery, etc.).
- There are over **6,100 H2-A visas** in Arizona, mainly in Yuma and many more who register in California but also work in Arizona, who come from Mexico to work temporarily on U.S. farms.

CAMPESINOS SIN FRONTERAS (CSF) OBJECTIVES



- CSF wants to learn more of the H2A/Guest farmworkers in our community that migrate to Yuma County.
 - Migration path
 - Where they come from & where going
- CSF goal is to educate workers and share the available resources through in person outreach, radio, messages, and social media.
- Through the Ulula platform, CSF inputs basic info (phone number, no names) of H2As surveyed, to send information and keep them up to date with the most relevant information. (All information uploaded is confidential & anonymous).

LABOR TRAFFICKING SITUATIONS IN YUMA COUNTY:

- Vulnerable to scams in their place of origin or in their migration passage.
- Threats of deportation/immigration consequences.
- Moving workers from job site to job site, so they do not form connections that allow them to seek help.


Key points:
